Additionally, Interfaith Neighbors will renovate and expand the existing storage garage on the site to add an on-site restroom and introduce a catering kitchen to allow us to continue our successful Farm to Table Dinner series with local guest chefs.

ROOTED IN COMMUNITY

The Kula Urban Farm is a social enterprise conceived by and established by Interfaith Neighbors in 2014 with the intention of further bolstering the economic outlook for Asbury Park and its West Side neighborhood.

The farm provides on-site job training, community and youth educational programs and fresh produce that's provided both for sale and for free to those in need.
