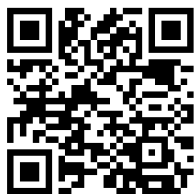

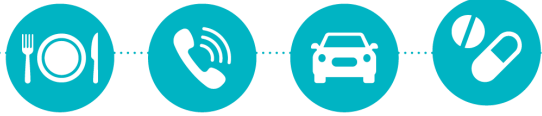
## March 2025 March for Meals

Eat Clean Bro delivers meals to Interfaith Neighbors in Asbury Park.

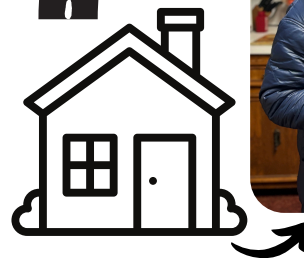
Interfaith Neighbors staff and volunteer drivers deliver meals and friendly faces to over 800 homebound seniors each weekday.
